SUBJECT: Contract Language Pursuant to Executive Order 96-236

In accordance with Executive Order 96-236, effective October 1, 1996, all state agencies under the authority of the Governor are directed, and all other agencies of the state are requested, to include as a standard provision in all future contracts they award to private contractors, language which informs those contractors that this state does not intend to award publicly funded contracts to those who knowingly employ unauthorized alien workers.

The Department of Management Services has revised the following language and should be included in future solicitations and contracts.

**NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR:**

The Department shall consider this a violation of Section 274A(e) of the Immigration and Nationality Act. Such violation shall be cause for unilateral cancellation of this contract. If the contractor knowingly employees unauthorized aliens.

As stated in the order, the Department of Management Services has developed the following language to be included in future solicitations and contracts:

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR:

The Department shall consider the employment by any contractor of unauthorized aliens a violation of section 274A(e) of the Immigration and Nationalization Act. Such violation shall be cause for unilateral cancellation of this contract.
