SUBJECT: Contract Language Pursuant to Executive Order 96-236

This memorandum corrects and replaces Memorandum 8(96-97) REVISED February 7, 1997.

In accordance with Executive Order 96-236, effective October 1, 1996, under the authority of the Governor all state agencies are directed, and all other agencies of the state are requested, to include as a standard provision in all future solicitations and contracts they award to private contractors, language which informs those contractors that this State does not intend to expend public funds to contractors who knowingly employ unauthorized alien workers.

The Department of Management Services has revised the following language that should be included in future solicitations and contracts.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR:

The employment of unauthorized aliens by any contractor is considered a violation of Section 274A(e) of the Immigration and Nationality Act. If the contractor knowingly employs unauthorized aliens, such violation shall be cause for unilateral cancellation of the contract.
