

SUBJECT: Printing

This memorandum is to provide clarification of the repeal of Purchasing Rule 60-A1.013, Printing, Florida Administrative Code, as it relates to the subcontracting of printing.

It has been brought to our attention that some agencies have interpreted the repeal of the aforementioned rule as allowing for the subcontracting of printing. Please refer to Section 283.33 F. S., the statute governing this subject. This statute allows for subcontracting for binding but it prohibits the subcontracting for printing, as defined in Section 283.30 (4) F. S., "Printing".

The repeal of Purchasing Rule 60A-1.013, FAC, did not change the meaning, effect, or application of Section 283.33, F. S. Printing cannot be subcontracted.
